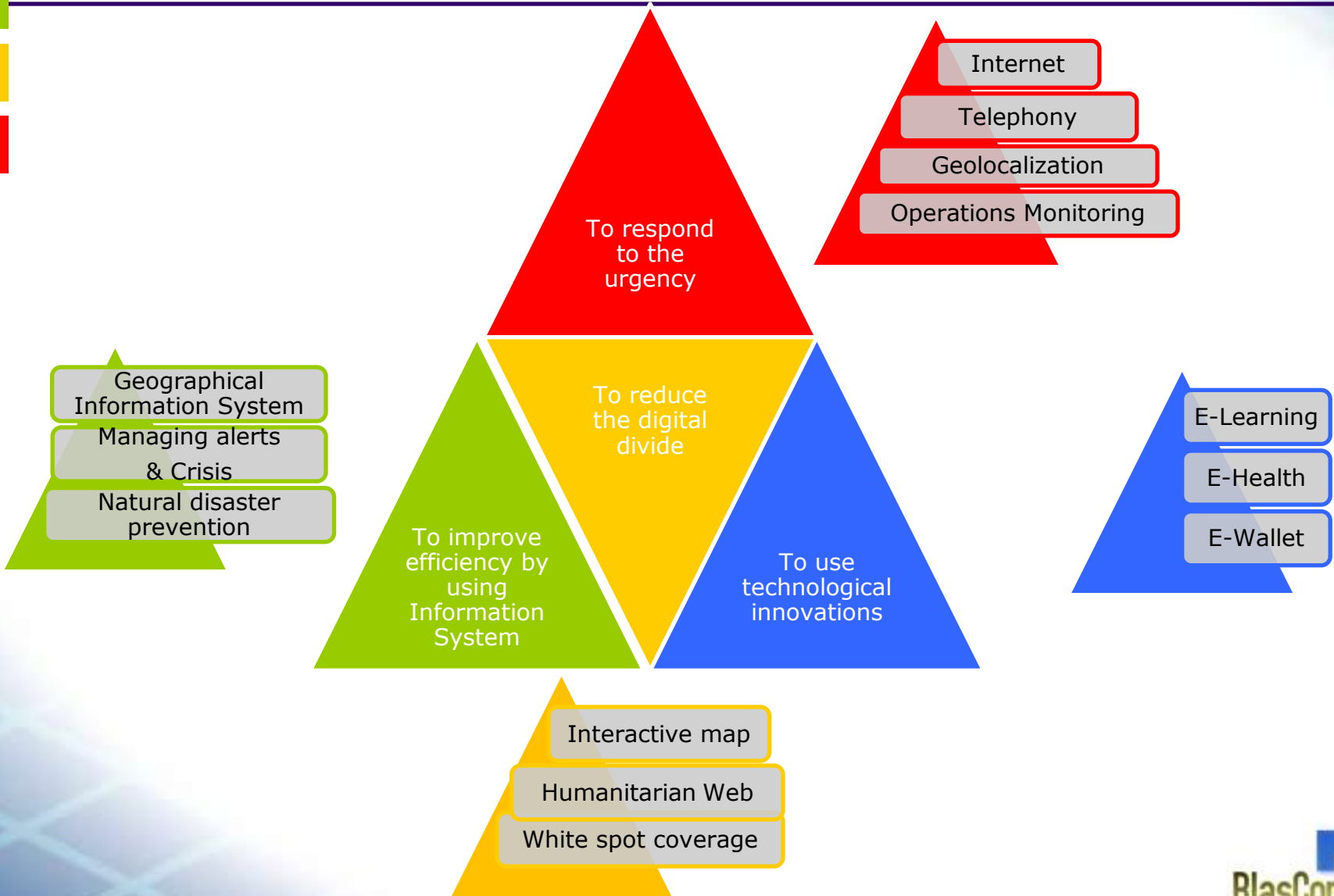

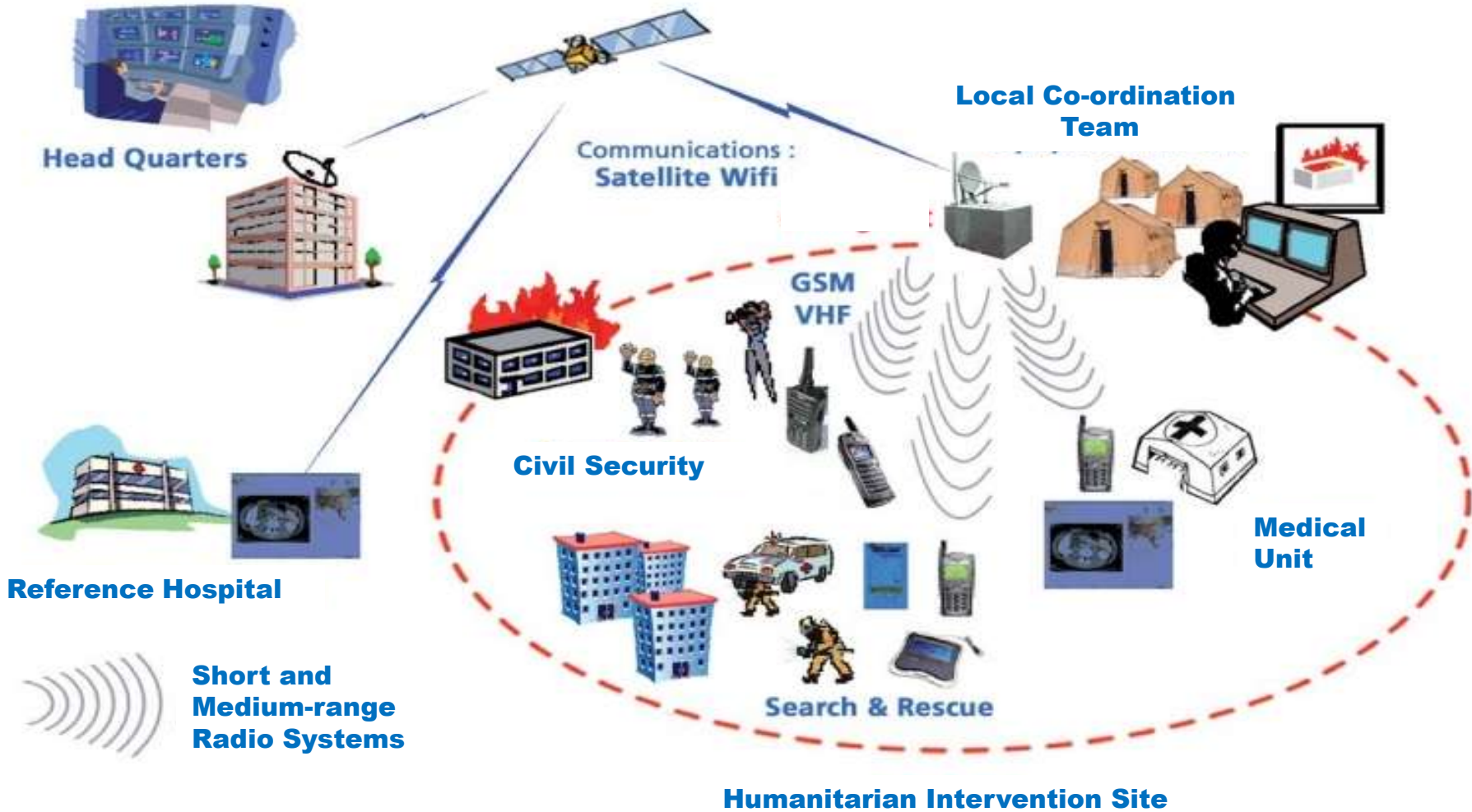


Available information before and after disasters is more and more digital and produced by users. Mobile technologies are used to send preventive alerts, and allows the populations affected to produce and to spread local real time information.

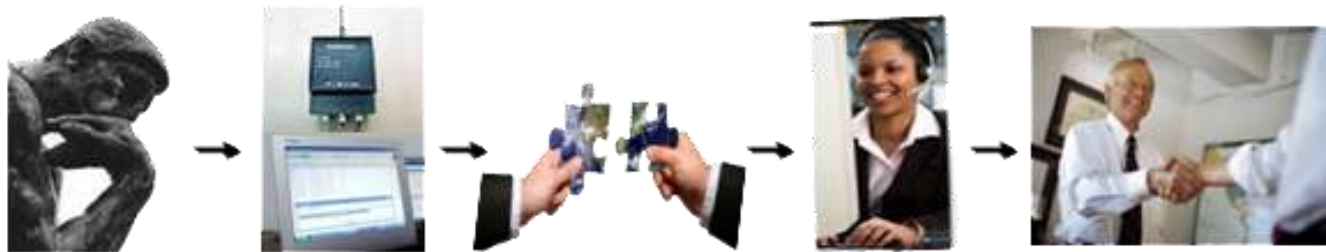

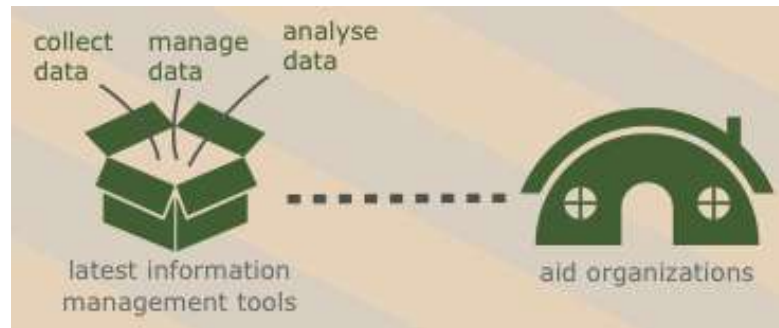
